Children	Education Wing	<b>Pre-K and Elementary classes are on summer break</b> and will resume on August 19, 2018.
Youth	Education Wing	<b>Youth Sunday School classes are on summer break</b> and will resume on August 19, 2018.
Adult Bible Study Class	Room A	We use <i>The Present Word</i> . This summer's study looks at God's grace-based justice focusing on Jesus' call for us to live it and Paul's teachings about it.. Each lesson stands alone, so join us any week to participate as you'd like.
Monday Connection	Parlor	This class is studying various topics over the summer, and is currently watching a video about Gladys Aylward, a missionary to China during WWII, who rescued 100 Chinese children from the Japanese.
Pastor Matt's Class	Library	This group is studying Adam Hamilton's <i>Christianity &amp; World Religions</i> . This video study explores 4 major world religions – Hinduism, Buddhism, Islam, and Judaism – and compares the beliefs of those with Christianity.

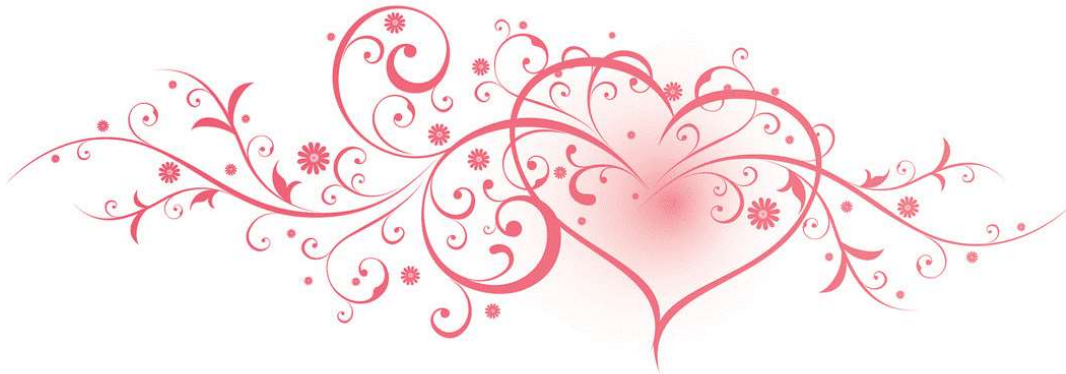
