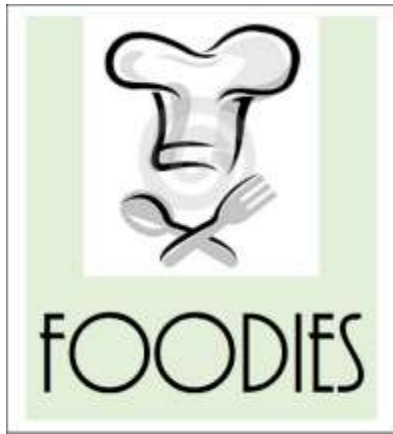
Class	Room	Topic
