Farragut Presbyterian seeks a musically gifted worship leader who will oversee and direct the contemporary worship team and all those they lead into worship to love God, love others, and make disciples.

Purpose of Job: Lead the contemporary worship team in the alternative Sunday service through instrument and/or voice

Essential Functions:

- Lead, recruit, develop, and rehearse the worship team while setting standards for musical excellence
- Work with the Pastor to select appropriate music according to the church worship calendar and connect music selection with service liturgy/theme, retaining a working knowledge of current modern worship songs and genres, as well as traditional hymns and using a diversity of musical styles
- Strive to create a memorable, cohesive, engaging worship experience through music and creative elements every Sunday
- Be responsible for securing all music copyrights and authorizations
- Supervise and coordinate with the Director of Music Ministries maintenance of musical instruments, obtaining necessary service and repairs
- Participate in meetings of the Worship and Music Committee
- Work with the Pastor, Director of Music Ministries, staff, lay persons, and the Worship and Music Committee to enrich the music ministry of the church

Minimum Qualifications:

- Has experience in the area of alternative worship music
- Professes Christian faith and a commitment to the expression of Christian faith in values through the gift of music in worship

Specialized Knowledge:

- Continuing education through conferences and events held by such professional organizations as the American Choral Directors Association and the Presbyterian Association of Musicians

Competencies:

- Solve problems; multitask
- Communicate effectively in oral and written forms
- Safely operate a variety of instruments and equipment as appropriate
- Operate desktop computer, laptop computer, and computer printer
- Use word processing, spreadsheet, and presentation software
- Work independently with minimal direct supervision
- Demonstrate good organizational and time management skills
- Works positively in a team environment toward a common mission

This is a 10 hour per week position within the Farragut Presbyterian Church Music Ministry and is accountable to and receives guidance from the Director of Music Ministries and Pastor as head of staff. Relationships with other program staff are collegial and cooperative in nature requiring mutual respect and teamwork.
