



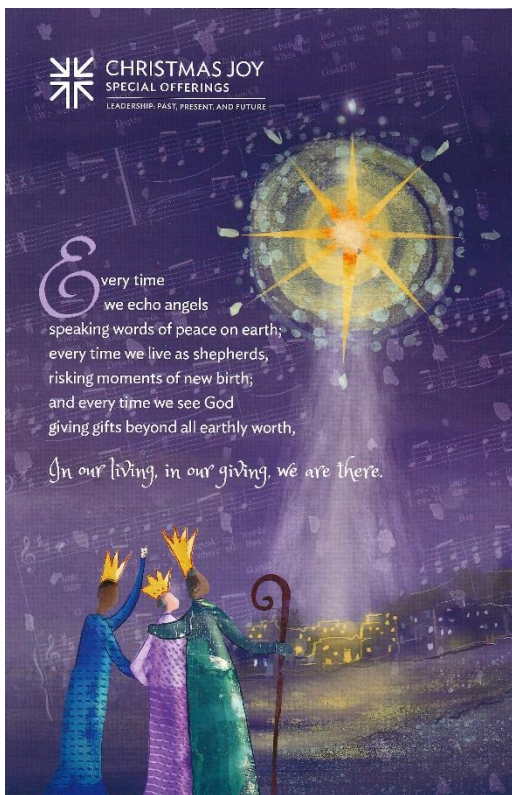
This Week at FPC
