American Red Cross Be prepared to "spring into action" with <u>FREE EMERGENCY</u> <u>PREPAREDNESS TRAINING</u> offered at FPC! <u>TODAY</u> after the 9 am and 11 am services – the American Red Cross will be offering training for children and adults who have an interest. Here's the line-up:

- <u>Childrens Preparedness</u> 10 am Jenny Trussell and friends will be teaching the "Prepare with Pedro the Penguin" program designed to teach children how to BE PREPARED and TAKE ACTION for home fires or local hazards (such as weather events). The 30 minute program is specifically for children in Pre-K 2nd grade (older children, visitors, and parents are welcome to attend).
- **Family Preparedness** 10 am and 12:30 pm Red Cross representatives will be giving a 20 30 minute presentation about simple steps you can take in advance to ensure you and your family are safe during bad weather or other emergencies.
- <u>Hands Only CPR</u> 10:30 am and 12 pm Red Cross representatives will be teaching "Hand Only CPR" for anyone with an interest. This is approximately a 30 minute course, which includes hands-on practice. Although this is not a formal CPR certification course, it teaches individuals how to deliver life-saving care until professional responders arrive.




