humankind, who gave himself a ransom for all. Praise the Lord!

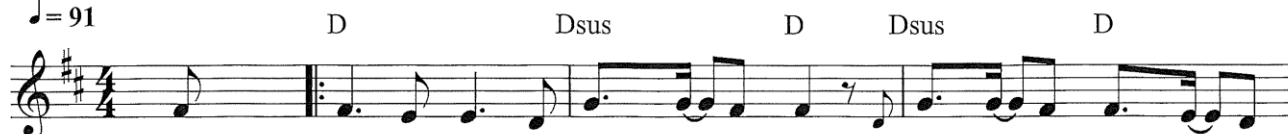
